All Things New

Matthew 26:26-30 - While they were eating, Jesus took bread, and when he had given thanks, he broke it and gave it to his disciples, saying, "Take and eat; this is my body."²⁷ Then he took a cup, and when he had given thanks, he gave it to them, saying, "Drink from it, all of you."²⁸ This is my blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many for the forgiveness of sins.²⁹ I tell you, I will not drink from this fruit of the vine from now on until that day when I drink it new with you in my Father's kingdom."³⁰ When they had sung a hymn, they went out to the Mount of Olives.

1 Corinthians 11:25 - In the same way, after supper he took the cup, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in my blood; do this, whenever you drink it, in remembrance of me."

Exodus 24:4-11 - Moses then wrote down everything the Lord had said. He got up early the next morning and built an altar at the foot of the mountain and set up twelve stone pillars representing the twelve tribes of Israel.⁵ Then he sent young Israelite men, and they offered burnt offerings and sacrificed young bulls as fellowship offerings to the Lord.⁶ Moses took half of the blood and put it in bowls, and the other half he splashed against the altar.⁷ Then he took the Book of the Covenant and read it to the people. They responded, "We will do everything the Lord has said; we will obey."⁸ Moses then took the blood, sprinkled it on the people and said, "This is the blood of the covenant that the Lord has made with you in accordance with all these words."⁹ Moses and Aaron, Nadab and Abihu, and the seventy elders of Israel went up¹⁰ and saw the God of Israel . . .¹¹ But God did not raise his hand against these leaders of the Israelites; they saw God, and they ate and drank.

Hebrews 10:4-7, 10 - It is impossible for the blood of bulls and goats to take away sins.⁵ Therefore, when Christ came into the world he said: "Sacrifice and offering you did not desire, but a body you prepared for me;⁶ with burnt offerings and sin offerings you were not pleased.⁷ Then I said, 'Here I am—it is written about me in the scroll—I have come to do your will,

my God.' . . .¹⁰ And by that will, we have been made holy through the sacrifice of the body of Jesus Christ once for all.

John 6:56-57 - Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood remains in me, and I in them.⁵⁷ Just as the living Father sent me and I live because of the Father, so the one who feeds on me will live because of me.

1 Corinthians 11:26 - For whenever you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until he comes.

Psalms 116:1-19 - I love the Lord, for he heard my voice; he heard my cry for mercy.² Because he turned his ear to me, I will call on him as long as I live.³ The cords of death entangled me, the anguish of the grave came over me; I was overcome by distress and sorrow.⁴ Then I called on the name of the Lord: "Lord, save me!"⁵ The Lord is gracious and righteous; our God is full of compassion.⁶ The Lord protects those of childlike faith, when I was brought low, he saved me.⁷ Return to your rest, my soul, for the Lord has been good to you.⁸ For you, Lord, have delivered me from death, my eyes from tears, my feet from stumbling,⁹ that I may walk before the Lord in the land of the living.¹⁰ I trusted in the Lord when I said, "I am greatly afflicted";¹¹ in my alarm I said, "Everyone is a liar."¹² What shall I return to the Lord for all his goodness to me?¹³ I will lift up the cup of salvation and call on the name of the Lord.¹⁴ I will fulfill my vows to the Lord in the presence of all his people.¹⁵ Precious in the sight of the Lord is the death of his faithful servants.¹⁶ Truly I am your servant, Lord; I serve you just as my mother did; you have freed me from my chains.¹⁷ I will sacrifice a thank offering to you and call on the name of the Lord.¹⁸ I will fulfill my vows to the Lord in the presence of all his people,¹⁹ in the courts of the house of the Lord—in your midst, Jerusalem. Praise the Lord.

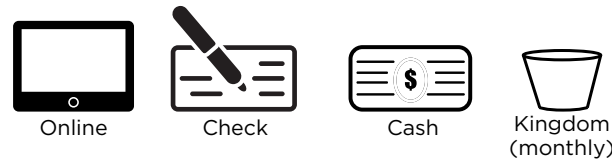

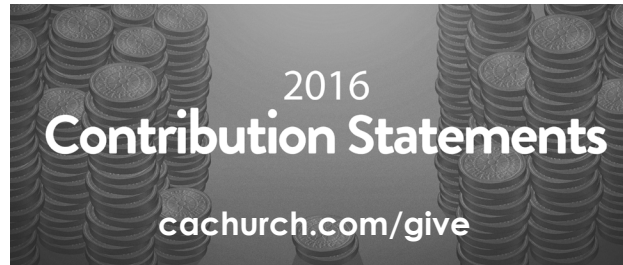

All contributions must be received or postmarked by Dec. 31 to receive tax credit for 2016. If you give online, submit by 11pm on Dec. 31.


