## Snapshots of Jesus

**John 19:1-6** - <sup>1</sup>Then Pilate had Jesus flogged with a lead-tipped whip. <sup>2</sup>The soldiers wove a crown of thorns and put it on his head, and they put a purple robe on him. <sup>3</sup>“Hail! King of the Jews!” they mocked, as they slapped him across the face.

<sup>4</sup>Pilate went outside again and said to the people, “I am going to bring him out to you now, but understand clearly that I find him not guilty.” <sup>5</sup>Then Jesus came out wearing the crown of thorns and the purple robe. And Pilate said, “Look, here is the man!”

<sup>6</sup>When they saw him, the leading priests and Temple guards began shouting, “Crucify him! Crucify him!”

“Take him yourselves and crucify him,” Pilate said. “I find him not guilty.”

**John 19:16-19** - <sup>16</sup>Then Pilate turned Jesus over to them to be crucified.

So they took Jesus away. <sup>17</sup>Carrying the cross by himself, he went to the place called Place of the Skull. <sup>18</sup>There they nailed him to the cross. Two others were crucified with him, one on either side, with Jesus between them. <sup>19</sup>And Pilate posted a sign on the cross that read, “Jesus of Nazareth, the King of the Jews.”

**John 19:28-30** - <sup>28</sup>Jesus knew that his mission was now finished, and to fulfill Scripture he said, “I am thirsty.” <sup>29</sup>A jar of sour wine was sitting there, so they soaked a sponge in it, put it on a hyssop branch, and held it up to his lips. <sup>30</sup>When Jesus had tasted it, he said, “It is finished!” Then he bowed his head and gave up his spirit.

**Matthew 27:45-46** - <sup>45</sup>At noon, darkness fell across the whole land until three o’clock. <sup>46</sup>At about three o’clock, Jesus called out with a loud voice, “Eli, Eli, lema sabachthani?” which means “My God, my God, why have you abandoned me?”

**Romans 3:23** - <sup>23</sup>For everyone has sinned; we all fall short of God’s glorious standard.

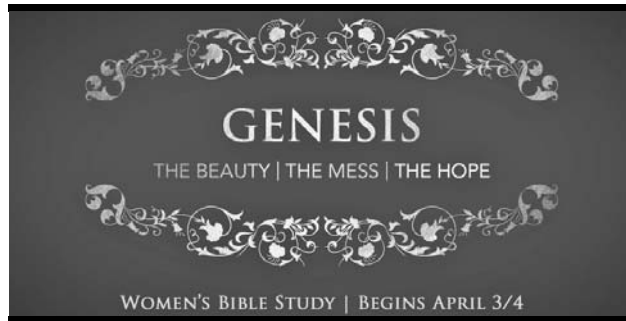
## NEW?
