John 6:1-15 (CSB) - ¹After this, Jesus crossed the Sea of Galilee (or Tiberias). ²A huge crowd was following him because they saw the signs that he was performing by healing the sick. ³Jesus went up a mountain and sat down there with his disciples.

⁴Now the Passover, a Jewish festival, was near. ⁵So when Jesus looked up and noticed a huge crowd coming toward him, he asked Philip, "Where will we buy bread so that these people can eat?" ⁶He asked this to test him, for he himself knew what he was going to do.

⁷Philip answered him, "Two hundred denarii worth of bread wouldn't be enough for each of them to have a little."

⁸One of his disciples, Andrew, Simon Peter's brother, said to him, ⁹"There's a boy here who has five barley loaves and two fish—but what are they for so many?"

¹⁰Jesus said, "Have the people sit down."

There was plenty of grass in that place; so they sat down. The men numbered about five thousand. "Then Jesus took the loaves, and after giving thanks he distributed them to those who were seated—so also with the fish, as much as they wanted.

¹²When they were full, he told his disciples, "Collect the leftovers so that nothing is wasted." ¹³So they collected them and filled twelve baskets with the pieces from the five barley loaves that were left over by those who had eaten.

¹⁴When the people saw the sign he had done, they said, "This truly is the Prophet who is to come into the world."

¹⁵Therefore, when Jesus realized that they were about to come and take him by force to make him king, he withdrew again to the mountain by himself.

John 11:41-44 (CSB) - ⁴¹So they removed the stone. Then Jesus raised his eyes and said, "Father, I thank you that you heard me. ⁴²I know that you always hear me, but because of the crowd standing here I said this, so that they may believe you sent me." ⁴³After he said this, he shouted with a loud voice, "Lazarus, come out!" ⁴⁴The dead man came out bound hand and foot with linen strips and with his face wrapped in a cloth. Jesus said to them, "Unwrap him and let him go."

1 Thessalonians 5:16-18 (CSB) - ¹⁶Rejoice always, ¹⁷pray constantly, ¹⁸give thanks in everything; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus.

Hebrews 12:28-29 (CSB) - ²⁸Therefore, since we are receiving a kingdom that cannot be shaken, let us be thankful. By it, we may serve God acceptably, with reverence and awe, ²⁹for our God is a consuming fire.

Psalm 100:3-5 (CSB) - ³Acknowledge that the Lord is God. He made us, and we are his his people, the sheep of his pasture.

⁴Enter his gates with thanksgiving and his courts with praise. Give thanks to him and bless his name.

⁵For the Lord is good, and his faithful love endures forever; his faithfulness, through all generations.
