**Matthew 2:1-12 (CSB)** - <sup>1</sup>After Jesus was born in Bethlehem of Judea in the days of King Herod, wise men from the east arrived in Jerusalem, <sup>2</sup>saying, "Where is he who has been born king of the Jews? For we saw his star at its rising and have come to worship him."

<sup>3</sup>When King Herod heard this, he was deeply disturbed, and all Jerusalem with him. <sup>4</sup>So he assembled all the chief priests and scribes of the people and asked them where the Christ would be born.

<sup>5</sup>"In Bethlehem of Judea," they told him, "because this is what was written by the prophet:

<sup>6</sup>And you, Bethlehem, in the land of Judah, are by no means least among the rulers of Judah: Because out of you will come a ruler who will shepherd my people Israel."

<sup>7</sup>Then Herod secretly summoned the wise men and asked them the exact time the star appeared. <sup>8</sup>He sent them to Bethlehem and said, "Go and search carefully for the child. When you find him, report back to me so that I too can go and worship him."

<sup>9</sup>After hearing the king, they went on their way. And there it was—the star they had seen at its rising. It led them until it came and stopped above the place where the child was. <sup>10</sup>When they saw the star, they were overwhelmed with joy. <sup>11</sup>Entering the house, they saw the child with Mary his mother, and falling to their knees, they worshiped him. Then they opened their treasures and presented him with gifts: gold, frankincense, and myrrh. <sup>12</sup>And being warned in a dream not to go back to Herod, they returned to their own country by another route.

**Deuteronomy 18:9-14 (CSB)** - <sup>9</sup>"When you enter the land the Lord your God is giving you, do not imitate the detestable customs of those nations. <sup>10</sup>No one among you is to sacrifice his son or daughter in the fire, practice divination, tell fortunes, interpret omens, practice sorcery, <sup>11</sup>cast spells, consult a medium or a spiritist, or inquire of the dead. <sup>12</sup>Everyone who does these acts is detestable to the Lord, and the Lord your God is driving out the nations before you because of these detestable acts. <sup>13</sup>You must be blameless before the Lord your God. <sup>14</sup>Though these nations you are about to drive out listen to fortunetellers and diviners, the Lord your God has not permitted you to do this.

**Isaiah 47:12-15 (CSB)** - <sup>12</sup>So take your stand with your spells and your many sorceries, which you have wearied yourself with from your youth Perhaps you will be able to succeed; perhaps you will inspire terror!

<sup>13</sup>You are worn out with your many consultations. So let the astrologers stand and save you—those who observe the stars, those who predict monthly what will happen to you.

<sup>14</sup>Look, they are like stubble; fire burns them. They cannot rescue themselves from the power of the flame. This is not a coal for warming themselves, or a fire to sit beside!

<sup>15</sup>This is what they are to you—those who have wearied you and have traded with you from your youth—each wanders on his own way; no one can save you.

Acts 17:22-24 (CSB) - <sup>22</sup>Paul stood in the middle of the Areopagus and said: "People of Athens! I see that you are extremely religious in every respect. <sup>23</sup>For as I was passing through and observing the objects of your worship, I even found an altar on which was inscribed: 'To an Unknown God.' Therefore, what you worship in ignorance, this I proclaim to you. <sup>24</sup>The God who made the world and everything in it—he is Lord of heaven and earth does not live in shrines made by hands.
